Burton Bradstock Services – NB Change to Post Office deliveries

- **Burton Bradstock Helpline:** 07425 412105 or email burtonbradstockvillagehelp@gmail.com. The Helpline has a wide range of services. If you need help or wish to volunteer please ring or email with details.
- **The Post Office & Village Shop** is open as usual and offers a delivery service. £10 minimum, order on Monday 9 am to 12 noon for Thursday morning. Phone 897243.
- **Modbury Farm Shop** is open (closed Sundays for restocking) and offers a delivery service – just phone up, leaving your number if you get the answerphone. Phone 897193.
- **Central Stores** is open and taking phone orders for picking up. Phone 897966.
- **The Three Horseshoes** has: a Sunday lunch takeaway service - order by 6 pm Friday for pick up or local delivery (if you are self-isolating) on Sunday between 12 and 2.30 pm; Thursday Curry – order by 5 pm Wednesday for pick up or delivery 6 - 8 pm Thursday, and “Friday Favourites” takeaway – order by 5pm Thursday for pick up or delivery 6 - 8 pm Friday.
- **The Parlour**, Bredy Farm, has a takeaway service with food collection on Wednesday – Saturday evenings 6 – 8 pm (from 5 pm on Thursdays), and Sunday roast noon to 3 pm. Phone 897899.
- **Nat’s Fish and Chips** van has a pre-order service alternate Mondays, next visit 25th May 6.30-7.30 pm. Text (preferred)/phone 07803257674 to order up until 5 pm the evening before and receive your collection time by text on the day.
- **Catch of the Bay:** fresh fish and shellfish Thursdays 10,.45 to 11.15 am by the Village Green.
