Khyam Allami first made his name as a drummer on London's punk rock scene. Born in Damascus to Iraqi parents, he began to study classical Arab music in 2004 and is regarded as one of the masters of the Arabic lute or oud.

Currently based in Tunisia, Allami's musical travels have taken him from Cairo to the BBC Proms and a sold-out performance with Blur at the London Olympic closing celebrations in front of an audience of 80,000!
