

Each week, members of our churches visit our two schools to act out Bible stories in a memorable way for all the children using a scheme now supported by the Bible Society. At Burton Bradstock this term, the team is dramatizing the parables that Jesus taught and began with the story of the prodigal son. The message of forgiveness and kindness came across and reinforced the school's mission statement of, 'Do justice, love kindness and walk humbly with God'. The Wagtails (reception) class had fun as the oinking pigs which were fed by the younger, errant son.
